

For Visitors Planning to Use the Parking Garage

If you're planning to park in our onsite garage and you're headed east towards 19th street on NW Flanders, the entrance will be to your right after passing the brick building at 1972 NW Flanders. If you're headed westbound on NW Flanders towards 20th street, the garage will be on your left, just beyond the drop-off area for the main sanctuary across the street. The garage door should sense your vehicle and open automatically upon approach. You will want to pull your vehicle to the right, slightly closer than you might think. After finding an available space, please head over to the interior door and ring the buzzer to notify our staff of your arrival. One of our staff will answer the door remotely and buzz you in. Once inside the door, you may take either the elevator or the stairs to reach the second floor. At the second floor, you'll notice a large tapestry on the wall. Enter the doorway on the left-hand side, where you will find our waiting room. Our board room entrance will be to the left, and the main office entrance will be to the right beyond a set of white double doors. A member of our staff will be glad to greet you and direct you to your meeting location whenever you're ready to begin.

For Visitors Parking in the Corner Lot

If you're planning on parking in our corner lot at the NE corner of Flanders and 19th street, you'll want to make your way to the brick building at 1972 NW Flanders, labeled the Schnitzer Family Center. The building is across the street from the main sanctuary on NW Flanders Street. Look for a set of glass doors and buzz the intercom on the right hand side to notify our staff of your arrival. Once you are let in, please feel free to take either the stairs or our elevator to the second floor. The elevator entrance can be found at the back of the foyer to the left. Once at the second floor, you'll notice a large tapestry on the wall. Enter the doorway on the left-hand side, where you will find our waiting room. Our board room entrance will be to the left, and the main office entrance will be to the right beyond a set of white double doors. A member of our staff will be glad to greet you and direct you to your meeting location whenever you're ready to begin.

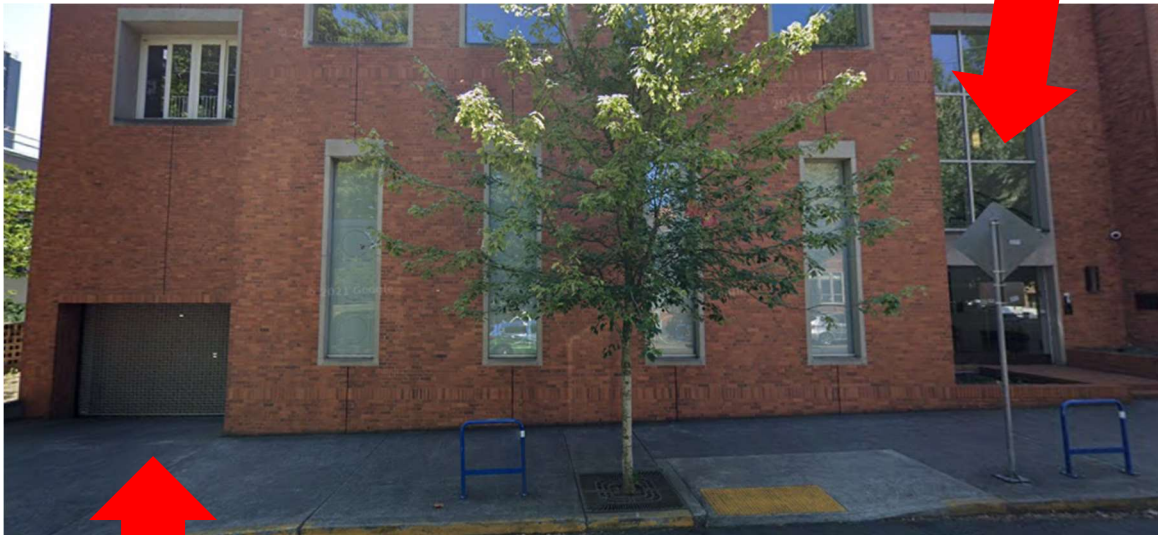
For Visitors Arriving on Foot or Using Street Parking

If you're planning on using street parking or arriving on foot, you'll want to make your way to the Schnitzer Family Center across Flanders street from the domed main sanctuary on NW Flanders Street. Look for a set of glass doors and buzz the intercom on the right hand side to notify our staff of your arrival. Once you are let in, please feel free to take either the stairs or our elevator to the top floor. The elevator entrance can be found at the back of the foyer to the left. Once at the second floor, you'll notice a large tapestry on the wall. Enter the doorway on the left-hand side, where you will find our waiting room. Our board room entrance will be to the left, and the main office entrance will be to the right beyond a set of white double doors. A member of our staff will be glad to greet you and direct you to your meeting location whenever you're ready to begin.
